Architecture and the Early Modern Books

Daniele Barbaro: In and Beyond the Text and Thinking 3D Projects

The International Network *Daniele Barbaro: In and Beyond the Text* (2010-16) put this protagonist of the cultural life of 16th-century Venice under the lens of his writings, and adopting a cross-disciplinary approach provided a reassessment of his figure in the context of the European Renaissance. *Thinking 3D* (2015-20) was centred on the developments of the techniques used to communicate 3-dimensional forms in 2-dimensional media, focussing in particular on early-modern printed books. Both projects were based on collaborative research and resulted in exhibitions, public talks, and academic symposia.
