The Renaissance in the Adriatic territories of the Kingdom of Naples

The Adriatic territories of the Kingdom of Naples were characterized by a certain distance from the capital, from which they were separated by the Apennines while remaining open to other realities both to the north and to the eastern Adriatic and the Islamic world of the great Ottoman Empire. The lecture will look at the specific features of the Renaissance in these territories, partly connected with the rest of the Kingdom, but at the same time subject to different and heterogeneous influences, which determined its autonomous and alternative character.
