Designing a Speculative Future


Axes of the Scenario



• Think like a futurist, feel like a poet

The plausible first brick: Scenario Planning

- 1. Define the problem
- 2. List the external drivers of change
- Consider the likelihood of each driver
- 4. Select (or vote upon) the two forces
- Create a scenario matrix with your two critical uncertainties on the axes
- 6. Use additional world building techniques to visualize, extend, and/or add layers/depth...
