Andrea Drocco is Assistant Professor in the Department of Oriental studies at Ca' Foscari University of Venice, where he teaches Indo-Aryan linguistics and the Hindi language. After receiving a PhD in Indological Studies in 2005 from the University of Turin, he has taught Indo-Aryan linguistics at the same University. His main area of research is the development of the alignment system of New Indo-Aryan languages, in particular in the period preceding the 19th century. He has published research papers not only on the morphosyntactic alignment of Braj-bhasha, Hindi and Bangani but also on the interpretation of the technical terms tatsama, tadbhava and deśī in the context of the Prakrit grammatical tradition.
