HEREBY DECREES

the publication of this call for application for the allocation of **7 scholarships**, each with a **maximum amount of € 5.980,00**, for **teaching mobilities** at Politecnico di Milano. The duration of each mobility is one month.

Art. 1 - Recipients

This call is addressed to professors from East Asian partner universities, invited to carry out teaching activities at Politecnico di Milano, in collaboration with local faculty. Participation in seminars and workshops is expected, with particular emphasis on green and digital transitions. During the mobility, the development of joint research activities on LEGO project topics is strongly encouraged, with the aim of producing joint publications.

Art. 2 - Application submission

Applications must be submitted via the following [online form](#) by **July 4, 2025**.

Applications must include:

- a curriculum vitae
- a mobility agreement, to be completed using the template attached (Annex 1)

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Art. 3 - Selection procedure

Applications will be evaluated by a selection committee based on:

- motivation of the mobility in the context of the [TNE-LEGO project](#)
- overall objectives of the mobility:
- foreseen activities
- expected outcomes and impact.

Selected applicants will be notified by **July 31, 2025** and must confirm acceptance of the scholarship within the given timeframe.

Art. 4 - Contributions

The scholarship will be granted, as a reimbursement, upon submission of receipts for travel, accommodation and board incurred during the mobility at Politecnico di Milano.

Only expenses made through traceable payment methods will be considered. The maximum reimbursable amount is €5.980,00.

All mobilities must be completed, and reimbursements processed, by March 31, 2026.
